James Righter – the analysand of **Elisabeth Severn**

On March 2 (Thursday), 2017, at 19.00 pm.

The conversation and discussion will be going on in English.

A special opportunity opens at the beginning of March when James Righter and his wife Sandy Righter come to Budapest for two days. James Righter was the analysand of Elisabeth Severn at his age of 16, in New York City.

This is the first time when he visits the House where his former psychoanalyst was analyzed by Ferenczi in the 30's – see Ferenczi's Clinical Diary. In this special evening he will share his personal experiences, and drawings he made during his analysis.

This rare moment becomes even more exceptional since the donation of the American psychoanalyst and well-known Severn-researcher Arnold Rachman has just arrived: the part of the collection of *Severn's legacy*. Rachman had donated the copies to the Sándor Ferenczi Society. The original documents he collected were offered to the Library of Congress.

So join us to listen James Righter unique presentation and share our joy about the arrival of the Severn legacy to the Ferenczi House.
