In relation to leadership theory, Kramer applies the ideas and thoughts of Otto Rank and Sándor Ferenczi. He has done some serious research and literary activities in connection with Rank's work. He is the editor of *Psychology of Difference: The American Lectures of Otto Rank* (Princeton University Press, 1996). His latest book was co-edited with E. James Lieberman:

The Letters of Sigmund Freud and Otto Rank: Inside Psychoanalysis.

The half an hour talk will be followed by a 20 minute discussion.
